Big Kids Camp

This program is designed for children who have completed kindergarten or early 5's through 5th grade. The program provides continuity between school years and gives our children a safe, fun place to be during the summer. Camp offers a variety of enrichment opportunities for your child. It allows children to see their friends, make new friends and establish positive relationships with other children and adults. Summer camp provides opportunities for children to be involved in the community by taking weekly field trips to various locations such as water parks, zoos, museums and other areas in the community.

Wee Kids I and Wee Kids II Camp

Wee Kids I and II Camp is a planned program of enrichment activities in a loving, nurturing environment for children ages 1-5 who have not attended kindergarten or early 5's. Children participate in a variety of activities which are both teacher directed and child initiated in a learn through play environment. Activities may include music, arts and crafts, stories, indoor and outdoor activities, snacks and rest time. Wee Kids II will participate in some selected activities with the Big Kids Camp.

Each week, camp will be centered around a theme. Big Kids and Wee Kids camp may slightly vary in themes due to age differences in the camps. In June, you will receive a packet that will give you more specific information on themes, field trips and requirements for Summer Camp.

Program Info.

- ◆ Registration for all summer and fall programs begin on March 21st, 2016. The Kids and Company office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00-4:00 with an hour lunch from 12:00-1:00. Packets are also available online at www.lapeerschools.org.
- ◆ The start date for summer camp is June 22nd and runs through August 26th. We will be closed July 1st and 4th in observance of Independence Day.
- ◆ Summer camp is held at Rolland-Warner in the Early Childhood wing.
- ◆ All children attending camp are required to bring their morning snack. They will be receiving breakfast and lunch through Lapeer Community School's Food Service Program *at no cost*. Kids and Company provides an afternoon snack. A bathing suit, towel, sunscreen and bug spray is required for each child.
- ◆ Electronics are not allowed on a daily basis. We may allow electronics on a special occasion.



Program Policies

- ◆ Each child will be provided a t-shirt, please be sure they wear this on field trip days.
- ◆ Your child's schedule must be completed in advance. We charge according to your schedule, not your child's attendance. Adjustments can be made only if the child attends more than he/she is scheduled.
- ◆ Any changes to your child's schedule must be made in writing and given to the Kids and Company secretary or staff member at least 2 weeks in advance. Other wise, billing will be done according to the last known schedule.
- ◆ All payments must be made in advance. Payments are due no later than the Friday before the week of service.
- ◆ Statements will be distributed by Wednesday of each week. Statements will reflect what is owed, according to your schedule, for the next week as well as state any balances owed. Balances must be paid upon receipt of the statement.
- ◆ Checks should be made payable to Lapeer Community Schools. Please include your child's full name with payment. Field trip fees must be made separately and cash or check (made out to Kids and Company).
- ◆ Payment should be turned in at the child care office or in the secure drop box outside the office. Payments can also be made through Payschools. Receipts will be left in your child's folder.
- ◆ Lapeer Community Schools will assess a \$20.00 fee charge on any returned check.
- ◆ All policies and procedures stated in the Kids and Company Parent Handbook continue to be followed in the Summer Camp program.



Program Rates

A non-refundable \$30 registration fee is due upon enrollment for families not registered in a child care program from the 2015-2016 school year. This fee holds your child's spot in the program.

Big Kids Camp (School Age Campers) Daily Rate:

5 hours or more: \$25

Less than 5 hours: \$15

Wee Kids II (Preschool Campers) Daily Rate:

5 hours or more: \$30

Less than 5 hours: \$20

Wee Kids 1 (Toddler Campers) Weekly Rate:

5 Days: \$165 per week

4 Days: \$152 per week

3 Days: \$130 per week

2 Days: \$96 per week

Field Trips :

Field trips are scheduled every week to various locations. All trips are subject to change due to weather and program needs. Children must wear their program shirt on the field trips. Please remember that if your child is in attendance on a field trip day, you have automatically granted permission for your child to attend that field trip. A field trip list will be distributed at a later date.
